TRAFFIC UPDATES FOR APRIL

Construction work will require lane closures at several locations on Waiakamilo Rd., Dillingham Blvd., and/or Hart St. Access to driveways will be maintained via right turn motions from the travel lanes fronting them; however, access to some driveways via left turn motions may not be available due to the presence of work area closures.

• Traffic Detour for Work at the Kalani Street Intersection

8:30 am to 3:30 pm, Monday through Friday

Left turns from Kalani Street in the Ewa bound direction onto Waiakamilo Road in the makai bound direction (towards Nimitz Highway) will be prohibited. Drivers affected by this closure will be detoured via Kalani St. and Kalihi St.
